### DAPHNE NICHOLLS - George Hogg

Daphne died after a short illness with pancreatic cancer on Boxing Day 2012 at Sue Ryder St. John's Hospice Moggerhanger. Our thoughts and prayers are with Roger, Heather and Andrew at this sad time.



It would be hard to find a fitter septuagenarian than Daphne. Her weekly activities included walking, Scottish dancing, English dancing, swimming and keep fit and all with a delightful smile. Her Scottish dancing started at least as far back as the 1960's and she was a founder member of the Bedfordshire Branch of the RSCDS, and a life member of the society. She eventually ended up on the Dancing Group's committee. She was a beautiful dancer and was a permanent member of the Bedford demonstration team, doing both country and highland dances. Typical of Daphne she never gave up and her last dance was a demonstration in October for the BBC as part of the Children in Need appeal. She was in hospital the following week. In the dance classes she would always seek out one of the poorer dancers for a partner, and help them through the dances, as well as making the tea. In addition to dancing she played the guitar and accompanied her husband Roger when he played

for a large variety of English country dance functions. She also raised thousands of pounds for leukaemia research making and selling marmalade and many other jams to the dancers and her other friends. Empty jars were always welcome. It was her personality that made her such a delightful person. Always willing to help, always smiling. She will be sadly missed by us all.

I hope most of you were at our New Year Ceilidh at the beginning of the month and enjoyed your evening. For any who weren't I can say that it was a great success as ever, thanks to George, our MC and Peter Scatterty's music, also the English and Scottish dance demonstration teams and Andy's piping. 

#### MAXWELL'S RANT (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s cross down to dance reflection reels of 3 on opposite sides 1-8
- 9-16 1s cross down to dance reflection reels of 3 on own sides
- 1s cross RH, cast to 2<sup>nd</sup> place & dance 1/2 Fig of 8 round 2s 17-24
- 1s lead down between the 3s, cast up to 2<sup>nd</sup> place & 2s+1s+3s turn partners RH 25-32

#### A CAPITAL JIG (J8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1-8 1s+2s Set & Rotate (end 1s facing up, 2s down)
- 9-16 1s dance reels of 3 on own sides (RSh to 2s)
- 17-24 1s set & turn RH to face own sides, 1s dance LH across (1L with 2s, 1M with 3s) to end 2<sup>nd</sup> place opposite sides
- 25-32 1s set & turn RH to face opposite sides, 1s dance LH across (1M with 2s, 1L with 3s) ending 2<sup>nd</sup> place own sides

#### LOMONDSIDE (S3x32) 3C set

- 2 turn 2H & dance out own sides between 1s+3s, cast round person on right, change places RH to end Lady 1-8 between 1s & Man between 3s
- 9-16 2s dance 1/2 RSh reels of 3 across (L with 2s & M with 3s) & 2s turn LH & dance 1/2 LSh reels with other couple (1s & 3s dance full reels) 2s turn LH to end facing 2<sup>nd</sup> corners
- 2s dance Pass+Turn with 2<sup>nd</sup> corners & turn RH to dance Pass+Turn with 1<sup>st</sup> corners ending in original places 17-24 25-32 1s+2s+3s set, 1s cross RH while 2s+3s dance RH across 1/2 way, 1s+3s+2s set & 2s cross RH while 1s+3s
- dance RH across 1/2 way. 312

#### THE FALLS OF ROGIE (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s cross RH & cast 1 place, 1s cross RH & cast 1 place (Man up Lady down) 1-8
- 1s dance 1/2 reels of 3 across (1M with 2s & 1L with 3s), set in lines across & change places RH with opposite 9-16 person
- 17-24 2s+1s+3s chase cl'wise 1/2 way, 1s dance in & turn RH to face 1st crnr pstns as 2s & 3s continue to chase on to places (as bar 16)
- 1s dance 1/2 reel of 4 with 1<sup>st</sup> corners, passing RSh dance 1/2 reel with 2<sup>nd</sup> corners & cross passing RSh to 2<sup>nd</sup> 25-32 place own sides

#### SETON'S CEILIDH BAND (J4x64) 4C set

- 1-8 1s cross RH & cast 1 place, lead down between 3s & cast behind 4s
- 1s dance reflection reels of 3 on opposite sides beginning by dancing up between 4s 9-16
- 17-24 1s cross RH & cast up 1 place, lead up between 3s & cast up behind 2s
- 1s dance reels of 3 on own sides beginning by dancing down between 2s 25-32
- 1s cross RH & cast down 1 place to give RH to partner & LH to 1<sup>st</sup> corners, Bal-in-Line & turn partner RH to give 33-40 LH to 2<sup>nd</sup> corners
- 41-48 Bal-in-Line & 1s dance out & cast down behind 3s, lead up to top crossing to 1<sup>st</sup> place own sides
- 49-60 1L+2L & 1M+2M change places RH on sides & 2s+1s cross over LH, repeat with 3s & 4s until reaching the bottom of the set
- 61-64 All turn RH 1.1/2 times

#### GANG THE SAME GATE (S8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1-8
- 1s cross RH & cast down to 3<sup>rd</sup> place, cross RH & cast up to 2<sup>rd</sup> place on own sides 1s set adv to ptnr & turn 1<sup>st</sup> crnr 2H to face 2<sup>rd</sup> crnr, 1s dance 1/2 reel of 4 ending M b'tw'n top cple facing down 9-16 & L b'tw'n bottom cple facing up
- 17-24 1s set adv to partner & turn 4<sup>th</sup> corner (pstn) 2H to face own 1<sup>st</sup> corner (pstn), 1s dance 1/2 diagonal reel with 1<sup>st</sup> corners ending in 2<sup>nd</sup> place opp sides
- 25-32 3s+1s+2s Set+Link for 3 twice

#### THE LOCHALSH REEL (R8x40) 3C (4C set)

- 1s turn RH, cast 1 place, cross LH, cast 1 place to meet partner in prom hold facing 3M (Lady on Mans left) 1-8
- 9-16 1s dance LSh reel of 3 across with 3s
- 17-24 1s split to dance reels of 3 on opposite sides
- 1s dance (nearer hands joined) to top, turn 2s with other hand, cross down between 3s & cast up to 2<sup>nd</sup> place 25-32 own sides
- 33-40 1s dance RH across (Lady with 2s & Man with 3s), pass RSh to dance LH across with other couple

#### THE RAVEN'S DANCE (J8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1-8 1s+2s dance double Fig of 8 (1s cross down & 2s out & up to start)
- 1s cross down to dance reflection reels of 3 on opposite sides & end facing down (Lady on Mans right) 9-16
- 17-24 1s (Lady leading) dance an Alternating Tandem RSh reel of 3 across with 2s (RSh to 2M) & end in centre facing down
- 1s dance down between 3s, cast up 1 place (opp sides), lead up between 2s, cross & cast to 2<sup>nd</sup> place own 25-32 sides

#### A TRIP TO BAVARIA (R4x32) 4C set

- 1s & 4s cross RH while 2s+3s dance 1/2 RH across, 1s+3s & 2s+4s change places LH on sides 1-4
- 5-8 3s & 2s cross RH while 1s+4s dance 1/2 RH across
- 9-16 Repeat bars 1-8 until back in original places
- 17-24 1s set to 2s & cross over to face 3s, set & cross to face 4s
- 25-32 1s set to 4s & cross over to 4<sup>th</sup> place on opposite sides, all Adv+Ret 2 steps 1s changing places 2H to retire to own sides

#### JOHNNIE WALKER (M-(S64+J64)) Sq.Set

- All circle 8H round & back 1-8
- 9-16 All set to corners & turn RH, set to partners & turn LH
- 17-24 1s & 3s advance to centre & lead out through sides with opposite partner, cross & dance to opposite sides & turn partner RH 1.1/2 times
- 25-32 2s & 4s repeat 17-24
- 33-40 All Ladies petronella one place to right & all set, Ladies petronella on to next place to right & set
- 41-48 All Men petronella one place to right & all set, Men petronella on to next place to right & set
- 49-64 All dance Grand Chain once round & dance Allemande anticlockwise
- 65-128 Repeat in Jig time

#### SWISS LASSIE (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s dance in & cast to 3rd place, 2s+1s turn partners RH 1.1/4 times to form a line up & down middle of set (Men 1-8 facing down Ladies up)
- 2s+1s dance reel of 4 up & down middle of set ending with 2M facing Ladies side & 1L facing Men's side 9-16
- 17-24 2s+1s chase round clockwise 1/2 way, 1s+3s+2s Adv+Ret
- 25-32 3s+2s 1/2 turn partners RH, dance RH across 1/2 way, 1s+2s 1/2 turn partners RH & dance RH across 1/2 way

#### INCHMICKERY (J5x32) 5C set

- 1s+2s circle 4H round to left, 1s dance in & cast to 3rd place 1-8
- 9-16 1s dance RH across (Lady with 3s & Man with 4s), pass RSh & dance LH across with other couple
- 17-24 1L+2M also 1M +5L turn RH, 1L+5M also 1M+2L turn LH (1s end 3rd place own side)
- 1s dance in & cast to 5<sup>th</sup> place, 5s+1s circle 4H round to right. 23451 25-32

#### MARGARET PARKER'S STRATHSPEY (S8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1-8 1s cross below 2s & cast down behind 3s, dance up, 1L dances LH across with 2M+3M & 1M dances RH with 2L+3L
- 1M+2L also 1L+2M continue to turn until 1s are in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 1s 3/4 turn 2H (to end Man above 2s & Lady 9-16 above 3s), 1M+2s also 1L+3s dance 3H round to left to end in lines of 3 across
- 17-24 Both lines dance down, all turning right about, dance back & end with top line turning to face 1L+3s
- 2s+1s+3s set & change places RH with person opposite, set, 1s cast into 2<sup>nd</sup> place while 2s & 3s change 25-32 places RH with opposite person

#### MR IAIN STUART ROBERTSON (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1-8 1s set advancing & turn 2H to face down & give nearer hand to 2s (2s face up), 1s+2s set & 1s turn 2s on sides with nearer hand
- 9-16 1s followed by 2s (who dance up to follow) dance down for 3 bars, 1s dance to top as 2s divide & follow, 1s cast to 2<sup>nd</sup> place & 2s to top & face out
- 2s+1s+3s dance reflection reels of 3 on sides (1s in & down to start, all giving hands where possible) 2s & 3s 17-24 ending with a loop
- 25-32 1s dance 1/2 reels of 3 across (Lady with 2s & Man with 3s), 1s dance 1/2 reels of 3 across (Man with 2s & Lady with 3s)

#### THE HIGHLAND RAMBLER (R8x40) 3C (4C set)


- 1-8
- 1s dance in & cast to 2<sup>nd</sup> place, dance RH across with 3s 2s+1s dance LH across, 1L followed by partner cast up round 2L & dance down middle to 1L between 3s & 1M 9-16 between 2s
- 1s+2s+3s dance down the middle & back 17-24
- 1M followed by partner cast down round 2L to 2<sup>nd</sup> places on own side & turn RH 25-32
- 2s+1s+3s circle 6H round & back 33-40

#### BRATACH BANA (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s turn RH & cast 1 place, 1s dance LSh round 1<sup>st</sup> corners to 2<sup>nd</sup> place opposite side facing 2<sup>nd</sup> corners 1-8
- 1s dance 1/2 Reel of 3 on the sides & dance 1/2 Reel of 3 across (1M with 3s at top, 1L with the 2s) 9-16
- 1s turn LH, turn 3<sup>rd</sup> crnrs RH (1<sup>st</sup> crnr person) & pass RSh to turn 4<sup>th</sup> crnr RH ending in 2<sup>nd</sup> pl own side in prom 17-24 hold with 4<sup>th</sup> crnr
- 1s+4<sup>th</sup> crnrs Prom diag across (pass RSh) to diag opp crnr & 1/2 turn to end 1s in 2<sup>nd</sup> pl opp side, 1s dance 1/2 25-32 Diag R&L (M up, L dn) to end in 2<sup>nd</sup> pl

#### THE IRISH ROVER (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s dance down below 3s & cast up to 2<sup>nd</sup> place own sides, 1L dances RH across with 2s while 1M dances RH 1-8 across with 3s
- 1s dance 1/2 diagonal reel of 4 with 1<sup>st</sup> corners, 1/2 reel with 2<sup>nd</sup> corners & 1/2 turn LH in centre to face 1<sup>st</sup> 9-16 corners
- 1s dance reels of 3 across giving LSh to 1<sup>st</sup> corners ending in 2<sup>nd</sup> place own sides 17-24
- 25-32 1s dance Diag R&L (1M crossing down & 1L crossing up to start)

#### A HIGHLAND WELCOME (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1-8 1s cross RH, cast 1 place & dance 1/2 Fig of 8 round 2s
- 9-16 1s, with promenade hold, dance 1/2 reel of 3 with 3s (RSh to 3m), and 1/2 reel of 3 with 2s (LSh to 2L)
- 1s dance mirror reels of 3 on own sides. 17-24
- 1s dance 1/2 Fig of 8 round 3s. 2s 1s & 3s set and cross RH (2<sup>rd</sup> time through, 1s & 3s set and dance 1/2 RH 25-32 across.

#### THE FLOWER OF THE QUERN (S8x32) 3C (4C set)

- I Boyd Caidin' O't 1s cross down to dance reflection reels of 3 on sides & 1s turn 2s (1M+2L LH & 1L+2M RH) to form line of 4 1-8 across face down (1s in centre)
- 1s+2s dance down for 3 bars, dance up to 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 1s dance to top & cast on opp sides as 2s follow dancing 9-16 up to top & casting into 1<sup>st</sup> pl
- 17-24 1s cross RH, cast down 1 place & dance up to top & cast into 1<sup>st</sup> place (2s step down)
- 1s+2s dance 1/2 R&L & turn RH 1.1/2 times 25-32

#### CASTLE OF MEY (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s dance Inveran reels with 2s+3s 1–8
- 1s+2s dance double Figs of 8 (1s start by crossing down) 9–16
- 17-24 1s lead down the middle & up, 1s end in middle of the set
- 25-32 1s+2s dance Pousette

#### THE DANCING MASTER (J96) Sq.Set

- J Drewry Donside Bk 1s & 3s set & pivot to right & dance round 1/4 cl'wise inside set (L follows M) & face in, 1s+3s change places 1-8 with other partner RH & dance clockwise back to partners place (M follows L)
- 9-16 1s & 3s dance RH across with corner 2L/4L, 1s & 3s dance across & LH across with other corner 4M/2M to end in pl facing cl'wise (M behind L)
- 17-24 1s also 3s dance Tandem reels of 3 with corners, 1s & 3s ending in prom hold facing out
- 25-32 1s & 3s dance clockwise 1/2 way round outside of set & dance in back to original places (pass RSh) while 2s & 4s (prom hold) Adv+Ret
- 33-64 2s & 4s repeat above Figs from beginning (bars 1-32)
- 65-72 All set to partners & change place RH, Ladies dance 3/4 RH across while Men cast 1 place clockwise to meet opposite Ladv
- 73-80 All repeat this Fig (bars 65-72) to end with own partners (opposite to where they started)
- 81-88 All dance 1/2 Schiehallion Reel (2 places) back to original places
- 89-96 All circle 8H round & back

#### FROM OCHTERTYRE TO AMULREE (S3x32) 3C set

- All Men set, all Ladies set & dance RSh round partner back to place 1-8
- 9-16 All dance the Knot to end 3, 2, 1
- 17-24 All Men dance LSh round partner, 1s lead down middle followed by 2s+3s, 3s divide & dance to bottom as 2s+1s turn in ready for...
- 25-32 2s+1s+3s lead up & 2s stand in top place while 1s+3s dance 1/2 Diamond Poussette

#### THE MEETING OF THE WATERS (R8x48) 3C (4C set)

- 1s+2s dance reel of 4 across (1M & 2L pass LSh while 1L & 2M cast), 1L ends facing out 1-8
- 9-16 1s dance parallel Figs of 8 round 2s & 3s on own sides (pass 2s RSh to start)
- 17-24 1L followed by 1M casts round 2L, cross down between 3s, cast up to 2<sup>nd</sup> place on Men's side & cross to own side as 1M ends Men's side
- 1s dance RH across with 3s & LH across with 2s 25-32
- 2s+1s+3s dance reels of 3 on own sides (1s giving RSh to 3s to start) 33-40
- 41-48 2s+1s+3s circle 6H round & back

#### A TRIP TO THE TROSSACHS (R8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1 41st and 2nd couples, taking hands on the side, set and dance right hands across half way round.
- 1st and 2nd couples, again taking hands on the side, set and, giving right hands to partner, cross over. 1st 5 – 8 couple remain facing out.
- 9-14 1st woman casts off below the 3rd woman, dances across the set below the 3rd man and casts up into second place on the opposite side. Meanwhile, 1st man casts up above the 2nd man, dances across the set above the 2nd woman and casts off into second place on the opposite side.
- 15 16 1st couple turn with the left hand to face first corner.
- 17 22 Reels of three on the side. 1st couple give left shoulder to first corner to start the reel.
- 23 24 1st couple, giving right hands, cross over to second place on own side.
- 25 32 1st, 2nd and 3rd couples dance six hands round and back.

#### WELCOME TO DUFFTOWN (J8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s 3/4 turn RH & dance Crown Triangles ending with Man between 2s & Lady between 3s all facing down 1-8
- 9-16 1M+2s also 1L+3s dance down the middle & back 1M+2s turning to face 1L+3s
- 1s change places RH, cast to right to 2<sup>nd</sup> place & turn RH while 2s+3s set facing on sides, change places RH, 17-24 set to partner & cross RH
- 25-32 1s dance diag R&L

#### ORWELL LODGE (S3x32) 3C set

- 1s+2s dance the Knot & 1s end facing 1<sup>st</sup> corners 1-8
- 1s dance 1/2 diagonal reel with 1<sup>st</sup> corners & pass RSh to face 2<sup>nd</sup> corners, 1s dance 1/2 diagonal reel with 2<sup>nd</sup> 9-16 corners & end 2<sup>nd</sup> place opp sides
- 17-24 All set & corner persons cast clockwise 1 place as 1s petronella turn into middle, repeat bars 17-20 with 1s ending 2<sup>nd</sup> place own sides
- 25-32 All set & turn partners 2H, 1s+3s dance 1/2 Diagonal Poussette. 2 3 1

#### POLHARROW BURN (R5x32) 5C set

- 1s & 3s cross RH, cast 1 place & dance 1/2 Fig of 8 round couple above them 1s & 3s turn RH then LH (long turns) to face 1<sup>st</sup> corners **while** 2s & 5s 1/2 turn RH & chase clockwise to other 1-8
- 9-16 end of set
- 17-24
- 1s & 3s dance 1/2 Reels of 4 with 1<sup>st</sup> corners then 2<sup>nd</sup> corners 1s & 3s dance 1/2 Reel of 4 with 3<sup>rd</sup> corner, turn partner LH & cast down 1 place own sides. 2 4 1 5 3 25-32

#### TRIBUTE TO THE BORDERS (J8x32) 3C (4C set)

- 1s cross RH & cast 1 place, turn RH 1.1/2 times to end in prom hold facing 2M 1-8 9-16 1s dance 1/2 RSh reel of 3 on Mans side, cross to face 3L & dance 1/2 RSh reel on Ladies side 1s end facing 3L (in top place)
- 17-24 1s set to 3L, turn & set to 2L, turn & set to 2M, turn & set to 3M ending with 3s+1s+2s in centre ready for Allemande
- 25-32 3s+1s+2s Allemande

#### THE DUNDEE WHALER (S4x32) 4C set

- 1-8 2s & 4s dance Petronella to opposite sides
- 9-16 1s+2s & 3s+4s dance Ladies Chain
- 17-24 1s & 3s dance Petronella to opposite sides
- 25-32 1L+2M change places LH, 1M+2L also 1L+3L change places RH, 1M+3M also 1L+4M change places LH & 1M+4L change RH

#### BLOOMS OF BON ACCORD (R4x32) 4C set 3s & 4s on opp sides

- All set & 1s+2s also 3s+4s dance RH across once round, 1s & 4s cast in 1 place to 2 1 (4)(3) 1-8
- 9-12 1s & 4s cross RH & cast to ends of set to meet partners in prom hold & dance into centre of dance
- 13-16 1s+4s dance round passing RSh & to end 1s in the middle on Men's side facing up & 4s in the middle on Ladies side facing down
- 17-24 All (1s & 4s in prom hold) dance reels of 3 on sides
- 25-28 4s+1s dance RH across in centre once round to end 4s facing up & 1s facing down
- 29-32 4s & 1s lead out of ends crossing & cast in 1 place to end 2 4 (1)(3)
